AIR TRAVEL INFORMATION

You will fly into the **Las Vegas McCarran International Airport (LAS)**, which is approximately 10 minutes from Bally's Las Vegas.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

OPTION # 1 – Taxis

Taxis can be found outside the airport terminal and the cost is approximately \$25.00 each way (subject to change).

OPTION # 2 – Bell Trans (*shuttle service to/from the airport*)

- Shuttle runs from 3:30am to 1:30am, approximately every thirty minutes (subject to change)
- The approximate cost is \$8.00 per person, one-way, and \$14.50 per person, round-trip (subject to change)
- Reservations are NOT required for your arrival
- For your return to the airport, they require that you make reservations at least two hours in advance
- If you arrive in Terminal 1 – after you pick up your luggage, go to their desk outside door #9 of the baggage claim area
- If you arrive in Terminal 3 – after you pick up your luggage, go to their desk outside door #52 of the baggage claim area

GETTING AROUND THE STRIP

Monorail Service

- The Las Vegas Monorail is a quick and easy way to get from one end of the Strip to the other in about 15 minutes
- There are a total of seven stops: MGM Grand, Bally's/Paris, Flamingo/Caesar's Palace, Harrah's/The Quad, Las Vegas Convention Center, Las Vegas Hotel, and Sahara
- The Monorail runs seven days a week, Monday from 7:00am-midnight, Tuesday-Thursday from 7:00am-2:00am, and Friday-Sunday from 7:00am-3:00am (subject to change).
- The approximate cost is \$5 for a single ride, \$12 for a one-day pass, \$22 for a two-day pass, and \$28.00 for a three-day pass (subject to change)

Bus Service

- There is a 24-hour bus service that travels from downtown to a substation south of the Mandalay Bay Hotel called the Deuce. It is a double-decker bus and is the least expensive way to travel the Strip.
- The approximate cost is \$8 for a 24-hour all-access pass and \$20.00 for a three-day, all-access pass (subject to change)
