TOUR DESCRIPTION	<p>This exciting adventure combines the thrill of whitewater rafting with magnificent views of the wild Gallatin Canyon. Under the fantastic rock walls of the Gallatin River Canyon, you'll plunge through famous rapids like Screaming Left, House Rock, and down the Mad Mile. Your family is sure to have a blast! Great for rafters of all experience levels. Lunch will be provided during the tour.</p> <p>Lunch to include: Burgers, brats, chicken tacos, pulled pork sandwiches, veggie quesadillas and/or salad, chips, fruit, dessert, and a variety of drinks (menu subject to change).</p> <p>Custom-designed rafting facility is complete with comfortable indoor changing rooms and a 30' climbing wall for kids and adults to enjoy.</p>
COST & INCLUSIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$80 per person (13 years and older) • \$70 per child (6 - 12 years old) <p>Children under 6 years old and pregnant women are not allowed on the tour and all participants must fit properly into a Personal Flotation Device (52" torso or smaller).</p> <p>Cost includes: Round-trip transportation to/from the Huntley Lodge, 3 hours of whitewater rafting, wetsuit and nylon jacket, lunch, and tax. Gratuities are not included.</p> <p>Recommendations: Bring cash for incidentals and gratuities (at your discretion). Cameras are not recommended unless they are waterproof. Bring/wear clothing that you don't mind getting wet (including footwear, unless you are renting booties) and no flip flops or crocs are allowed. Bring a long sleeve fleece or sweatshirt to wear on the river (it can get cold) and dry clothes to change into after your rafting tour. Indoor changing rooms are available, however, please leave valuables (jewelry, phones, etc.) at the resort as there are no lockers on site.</p>
