AIRLINE TRAVEL INFORMATION

ARRIVAL FLIGHT: You will fly into Budapest, Hungary (Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport, airport code – BUD), which is approximately 40 minutes to the cruise port.

It is recommended you **allow a minimum of five hours from the time your flight arrives in Budapest** to the time the ship departs (at 9:30pm).

DEPARTURE FLIGHT: You will fly out of Munich, Germany (Munich Airport, airport code – MUC), which is approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes from the cruise port in Vilshofen.

Going home, it is recommended you **allow at least six to eight hours between when the ship disembarks in Vilshofen and the time your plane departs Munich, Germany (disembarkation starts at approximately 9:00am).** The five to eight hours allow you time for ship clearance, transportation to the airport, customs clearance (if applicable), and airline security. You can also request to be one of the **first groups to depart the ship** by going to the Reception Desk as soon as possible once you board the ship and letting them know that due to a tight airline schedule, you need to be included in the first group off the ship.
