These appropriate valid travel documents such as passports, visas, inoculation certificates, and/or family legal documents are required for ship boarding and country entry and/or re-entry into the United States and other countries. Based on citizenship, some countries require an entry visa.

Guests who do not possess the proper documentation may be prevented from boarding their flight or ship, or from entering a country, and may be subject to fines.

Note: No refunds will be given to individuals who fail to bring proper documentation.

AIRLINE TRAVEL INFORMATION

You can fly into either the Heathrow International Airport (LHR), which is an approximate 1½ hour drive to the port, or Gatwick International Airport (LGW), which is an approximate 2 hour drive to the port.

If you purchase Air Transportation through Celebrity's ChoiceAir® Program:

IF YOU MAKE AIR ARRANGEMENTS ON YOUR OWN:

If you make your own air arrangements, you should allow a minimum of three to four hours from the time your flight arrives in England to the time you must check-in at the ship (by 2:30pm). Note: Ship check-in begins at 10:30am and concludes at 2:30pm. Going home, you should allow at least five to six hours between when the ship disembarks in England and your plane departs (disembarkation starts at approximately 7:00am). The five to six hours allow you time for ship clearance, drive time to the airport, customs clearance (if applicable), and airline security. You can also request to be one of the first groups to depart the ship by going to the Guest Relations Desk as soon as possible once you board the ship and letting them know that due to a tight airline schedule, you need to be included in the first group off the ship.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

If you choose to make your own air travel arrangements, you can purchase Celebrity Cruises® transfers to/from the ship. Once you have arrived and collected your luggage at the airport, you will be met by a Celebrity Cruises® representative outside the Baggage Claim area who will assist you with transportation to the ship. When you return from your cruise and have claimed your luggage, a Celebrity Cruises® representative on the pier will direct you to your transportation to the airport. Note: The transfers are available for either airport, and only available on the scheduled day of ship embarkation (June 27, 2020) and disembarkation (July 4, 2020) based on flight times.
